

# Youth and Community Work

## Level 2

**Aims of the course:** To provide a route into professional youth work qualifications, or into working with young people in other settings such as: youth justice, leisure, arts or health and social care.

The course is aimed at those involved in youth work on a full-time, part-time or voluntary basis

**Dates:** One evening per week over a four month period.  
Plus individually arranged Tutor/Assessor meetings

**Venue:** Star House, 43 Division Street, Sheffield S1 4SL

**Content:**

- establishing relationships with young people
- working as an effective/reflective practitioner
- promoting Equality of Opportunity, Participation and Responsibility
- working with young people to design and develop sessions
- enabling young people to be active citizens
- working with young people to safeguard their welfare

The course will consist of a variety of learning methods. Emphasis will be placed on the sharing of work experience between course members. A number of approaches will be adopted: group discussions, presentations, lectures etc.

Participants will be expected to produce a portfolio of evidence demonstrating their competence in the units and elements of the course. Some sessions will be put aside for portfolio building workshops. There will be course work assignments to be completed in the candidate's own time. Tutorial support will be available throughout.

It will be possible to discuss course details further at an informal interview to which all participants are invited.
